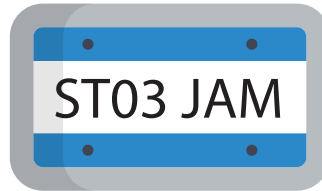


Let's be number detectives!

What numbers can we spot on a car registration plate?



Notes for parents or teachers

On your walk, stop at 10 different cars that are parked and get the child to write down the registration.

If writing is difficult then you can always take a photo of each one and then write them down when you get home.

Look at the first registration plate together...

Example: CM53 RPS

What numbers can you see?

5 and 3. Let's write those down.

Can we add those 2 numbers together?

This will be easier to do with objects. So for this example you would gather together 5 objects in one space and 3 objects in another.

Now ask the child to count what is there altogether...

1...2...3...4...5...6...7...8 So we know that 5 plus 3 is 8.
