The second part of this task can only be completed when you have made your instruments (make sure everyone in the group has one!) You need to choose 1 of your instruments and write a set of instructions to explain how to make this instrument. This can be completed on the attached lined sheet, or in your lined exercise book.

Your instructions should include the following:

- an Equipment List (everything that you need to make it)
- a Labelled Diagram (to show where the parts go)
- Numbered Steps (to keep the instructions in order)
- Time Phrases (firstly, next, then, after that, finally, etc)
- Imperative Verbs (bossy verbs such as, stick, stretch, cut, fold, pour, etc)
- Prepositions (underneath, next to, beside, on top of, around, over, etc)
- Conjunctions (and, so, but, because, however, when, etc)

When you have written your Instrument Instructions, don't forget to proof-read your writing to check that it makes sense. You can use the list above to check whether you have included everything. Please edit your writing as needed (with a coloured pencil if possible). Remember, it doesn't have to be perfect but you do need to show me that you have tried your best!
