1. A fisherman had 9 fish in his net, but as he pulled it from the water, 2 fell out. How many fish did he have left?



2. There were 4 starfish on the sand, 3 starfish in the water and no starfish on the rocks. How many starfish were there altogether?



3. Ash saw 7 jellyfish and 8 seahorses. Altogether, how many animals did he see?



4. Sal swam for 3 hours in the morning, and 2 hours in the afternoon. For how many hours did she swim in total?



5. A wave washed 6 shells up onto the shore. Another wave came and added 4 more. How many shells were washed onto the shore altogether?



6. 17 seahorses were in the water, but a jellyfish scared 8 of them away. How many were left?
