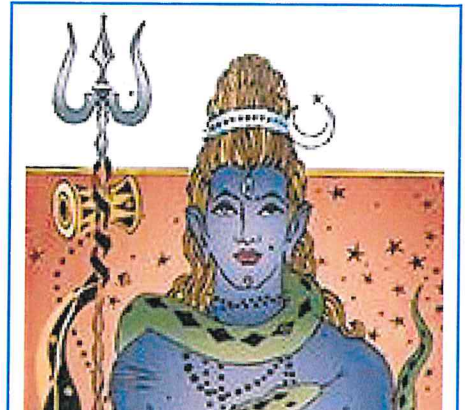
Each of the Hindu gods has symbols associated with them which represent their characteristics.



This is Brahma the Creator. He often has four heads to show that he sees all things. He carries a book, which symbolises knowledge.



This is Vishnu the Preserver. The shell represents the power to create, and the crown represents his authority.



This is Shiva the Destroyer. He often has a third eye in the middle of his forehead and carries a trident to destroy evil.
